Youth Permission Form

RAFT (Resource Area for Reaching) appreciates your time and we will do our best to ensure that your volunteer experience is rewarding, productive and safe. All volunteers under age 18 must have a signed youth permission form on file at RAFT. Youth volunteers must be at least 14 years of age. Youth ages 12-14 may volunteer with a parent.

1. Follow staff instructions and complete duties as assigned. Ask for help, as needed. Report possible hazards or unsafe activities to RAFT staff.
2. **Closed toed shoes are required.**
3. Running, shouting, horseplay, playing with items in the store, riding pallet jacks, walking or stepping on pallets is not permitted in the volunteer area and the RAFT Store.
4. Harassment of any kind is not tolerated by staff or volunteers. Any behavior intended to create discord or restrict other volunteers or staff from working will not be tolerated. Report incidents immediately to staff.
5. All personal belongings, purses, backpacks, computers etc should be left in your vehicle or at home. RAFT assumes no responsibility for damage or loss of personal property of volunteers
6. If working for the full day, volunteers are required to take a lunch from 12pm-1pm and no volunteer work is to be done. Volunteers are encouraged to bring a lunch and snacks.
