Materials List

- ✓ Yogurt tub ~2 liter (64 oz.) size
- ✓ Cardstock
- ✓ Markers/paint
- ✓ Scissors/utility knife
- ✓ Glue, if needed
- ✓ Optional: Decorative items such as stickers, feathers, yarn

Tub Hat Make your own brimmed hat



A quick and easy way to make a sombrero, cowboy hat, or any other brimmed hat!

Assembly

- 1. In the center of the cardstock, lightly trace the open end of the yogurt tub.
- 2. Draw smaller circle inside the traced circle. It should be about a centimeter $(\sim 1/2")$ or so smaller than the traced circle so that it fits tightly around the tub.
- 3. To make the brim of the hat, draw a larger circle around your traced circle. Make the outer circle as large or as small as you need for the type of hat you are making. See **Taking It Further** Below.
- 4. Cut out the largest circle and the smallest circle.
- 5. Slide the cardstock over the tub. It should now fit snugly. (If the brim and the tub are not fitting snugly a thin bead of glue around the edge can be applied).
- 6. Decorate!

Taking it Further

You can make any kind of brimmed hat with this activity. Here are a few ideas with additional instructions.

- 1. Sombrero- Make a big circle for the brim, approximately 5 inches out from the smallest circle. Punch holes around the brim and tie yarn with beads, circles or whatever to each hole. Perhaps paint the colors of the Mexican flag.
- 2. Cowboy hat- The brim for this hat could vary from 3 to 4 inches from the smallest circle, and could be wider on the sides like an oval instead of a circle. Curl up the sides to look like a genuine ten-gallon hat. Punch a hole close to the tub on either side and string some long leather or yarn between them to make a kissing strap.
- 3. Derby or fedora- Make the brim less than 2 inches from the smallest circle. Curl the sides for a derby and the back and one side of the front for a fedora. After coloring/painting wrap some ribbon or leather around the base of the tub. Add a feather, if desired.

Try any of these hats for a fun and easy art project, or create your own hats and get silly!
